# Santhe at GKVK: Buyers and Sellers Platform

**UAS, BANGALORE** organised *Santhe* – a platform for buying and selling of agricultural products on 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2024 at GKVK Campus with the goal of educating the general public and farmers about the activities and products offered by the University. At the program's opening, Shri N. Chaluvarayaswamy, Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture, GoK and Pro-Chancellor of UAS-B congratulated the University for hosting the Santhe for the first time in the institution's existence. The main attractions included Seeds. Aromatic & Medicinal Plants, Bio-Pesticides, Bio-Fertilizers, Agricultural Implements, Vermicompost, Organic Jaggery, Honey, Value

Added Products from Silkworm Cocoons & Banana plants, Rajmudi Rice, Coconut Oil, Jack fruit and its products, Value added products of Millets, Bakery Products, Ready-to-Cook Powders, Pickles, etc. Dr. S.V. Suresha, Vice-Chancellor of UAS, Bangalore, chaired the programme and stated that throughout the course of its sixty-years of existence, the University has developed 328 varieties and 485 technologies, making it the leading Agricultural University in the state. He claimed that these varieties have all contributed to an increase in the State's overall agricultural output and are still favoured by farmers across the country. Furthermore, the University's improved varieties have transcended state and national borders, with over 400 quintals of sunflower seeds shipped to African Nations, he added. Over fifteen thousand farmers, public, faculty & students and Members of Board of Management of UAS-B took part in the event.

**THE COMPREHENSIVE SCHEME** for studying cost of cultivation of principle crops in Karnataka, housed at the Department of Agricultural Economics, GKVK, Bengaluru, organised an Annual Meeting and Training Programme on 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2024 for the benefit of the 55 field workers involved in the project. The Vice-Chancellor, Dr. S.V. Suresha, gave the program its start and emphasized the importance of economists in assessing agriculture enterprise profitability, both on farmers' fields and on University



farms. He placed a strong emphasis on improving technological adoption and resource efficiency to lower agricultural farming costs. Dr. M.A. Shankar, former Director of Research who was invited as a special guest, mentioned that the data gathered is crucial to the Government of India's announcement of the MSP and that field workers are the scheme's cornerstones. The event was facilitated by Dr. H.S. Shivaramu, Director of Research, who emphasized the need for producing high-quality data and designating Arecanut and chilli as mandatory crops due to their recent increases in area and productivity. Dr. H. Lokesha, Professor & Head, Dept. of Agril. Economics and Dr. Jagannath Olekar, Field officer, CCS scheme were present.

# **Kick-off meeting of Climate Smart Agriculture**

THE KICK-OFF MEETING of the India-Netherlands Climate Smart Agriculture program funded by Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Government of India and Dutch Research Council (NWO), Government of The Netherlands was held from 26-28 June, 2024. Coordinating the meeting, Dr. M.S. Sheshshayee, Professor & University Head, Department of Crop Physiology, CoA, GKVK, Bengaluru said that mitigating the effects of climate



change on agricultural processes has highest relevance to developing countries in the tropical world like India for which, proposals were called jointly by the governments of India and the Netherlands. He added, out of 85 proposals submitted under this call, only three had been successful and UAS, Bangalore, is one of the recipients of this grant. The Kick-off meeting for the three projects funded in the joint DBT-NWO call on Climate Smart Agriculture facilitated productive interactions and knowledge sharing, while also helping find potential synergies between projects. Mr. Ewout de Wit, Consul General of the Kingdom of Netherlands was present at the meeting. Dr. Basave Gowda, Registrar of UAS-B presided over the meeting in the presence of NWO representatives Dr. Monika Brasser and Dr. Berry Bonenkamp.
