58th Convocation of UAS, Bangalore

UAS, BANGALORE ORGANISED ITS 58TH CONVOCATION on 4th March, 2024 formally with tradition and symbolism to confer various Degrees to graduated students. Dr. S.V. Suresha, Vice-Chancellor welcomed the dignitaries & all others and presented the significant achievements of the University. Shri Thawarchand Gehlot, Hon'ble Governor of Karnataka and the Chancellor of the University awarded Degrees the Gold Medals in the august presence of Shri N. Chaluvarayaswamy, Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture, Govt. of Karnataka. In total, 1244 students were conferred with various degrees of which 870 students received Bachelor's Degrees, 291 students received Master's Degrees and 83 students were awarded Doctoral Degrees. In Doctoral degree programmes, 12 girls and 4 boys were awarded 15 University Gold Medals, 10 Donor's Gold Medals and 4 Donor's Gold Medal Certificates. In Master's degree programmes, 24 girls and 6 boys received 22 University Merit Gold Medals, 5 Campus Gold Medals, 31 Donor's Gold Medals and 11 Donors Gold Medal Certificates. In Undergraduate degree





programmes, 4 boys and 13 girls were awarded with 6 University Merit Gold Medals, 4 Campus Gold Medals, one UAS Sports Gold Medal, 40 Donor's Gold Medals and 7 Donors Gold Medal Certificates. Honourary Doctorate was awarded to Shri M.C. Rangaswamy, progressive farmer of Arakalagudu, Hassan district. Hon'ble Governor motivated the faculty to strive to take the University a top class international institution in the arena and called to develop agriculture on business mode by maintaining a healthy ecosystem. Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture highlighted the repercussion of climate change and the need for healthy cultivation system and urged graduates to focus on value addition and marketing techniques to enhance farm income. UAS-B Online Seed Portal

UNDER THE UAS-B'S FLAGSHIP PROGRAMME to produce Quality Seeds at affordable prices for farmers, AICRP on Seed (Crops) for agriculturally important crops produced seeds of 99 varieties and 28 hybrids to cater to the requirement of Government and NGOs. On an average 30000 to 35000 quintals of quality seeds are being produced and supplied to the farming community annually.



In order to address the challenge to reach remote villages, the University has embarked on a bold initiative by creating an online seed sales website (www.uasgkvkseeds.org) which was launched by Shri Chaluvarayaswamy, Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture, Govt. of Karnataka in the presence of Dr. S.V. Suresha, Vice-Chancellor and Dr. Madhusudhan, Special Officer (Seeds), NSP, GKVK. The portal ensures bolstering the sales of genuine seeds of required varieties ensuring sufficient quantity of quality seeds, that align with the unique agroclimatic conditions, to mitigate the risk of substandard seeds infiltrating the seed supply chain.
